The following are the findings of IAD SPECIALIST, OMAR SPIKES (O.S.) and excerpts from mandated mental competency sessions conducted by department Psychologist, Irving Talbot (I.T.)

With regard to subject "Daniel Credence", conclusions are as follows: Uncompromising, unapologetic and reckless with a need to push boundaries. Career and personal life dangerously intertwined. Credence is someone who will endanger himself and others in the pursuit of a "greater good". Subject appears to subscribe to the notion that to capture an "outlaw" you must become one. Often finds himself teetering on the brink of depravity. At the same time subject appears to understand just how deluded he was in believing he could function for so long while slowly destroying himself. (I.T.)

As fast with his fists as he is with his mouth. Admits to having "put stuff up his nose and shot it in his veins; stuck his dick in places it never should have been." Went "down the rabbit hole" and only came up for air when his wife, Gina, walked out on him with their son, Dylan. (0.5)

Subject's life philosophy: "I see twelve inches in front on my face and there's usually a fist coming behind it. You're going to get hit. You're going to get hit hard". (I.T.)

In 2011, subject was youngest recipient of a Gold Shield in precinct history. Successfully promoted seven consecutive years. Detective Credence has received six full accommodations for valor and three partial. Considered to be a rising star in



Subject on love: "You're born alone, you die alone. Along the way, maybe a nice girl lets you between her legs." (I.T.)

Subject has been known to "coerce" confessions and exchange seized narcotics to informants for information. Suspended on at least two occasions for illegal wiretaps and unauthorized surveillance. Suspended once for excessive force (charges dropped.) (0.5)

Subject on childhood: "TV stations used to go off the air at night. God Bless America and Ray Charles' voice. I miss it. And that's not the in-my-day shit. Because in my day, when the old man wasn't beating the shit out of me and my mom, he was treating the dog like a foot stool." (I.T.)

Subject has become obsessed with "taking down" Russian born serial killer Andras Golovkin by any means necessary. Credence seems to believe this will somehow redeem himself in the eyes of his estranged wife and son. (I.T.)

Subject Appears to understand aspects of the Golovkin investigation that only the killer would know. Subject considered to be a suspect himself. (O.S.)





Subject on family: "In my family you're either going to be a cop, a criminal or a corpse. There's four of us on active duty. Two retired. One's in the ground and one's doing fifteen to life. That's the one I call Dad." (I.T.)

Despite brutish behavior, subject exhibits above average intelligence and appears to "know more about Kierkegaard than Herpes." (I.T.)





#### GENERAL NOTES:

Subject has been observed walking a three-legged dog.

In 2015 spent thirty days at Robinson Treatment Center (Harlem) for addiction to cocaine and Methadone.

In 2012 was hospitalized at NY Presbyterian Hospital with knife wound that required nineteen stitches. Responding Officer reported Ex-Wife Gina attacked him with kitchen knife. Credence refused to press charges.

Surveillance findings suggested Credence is currently having sexual relations with his partner's wife.

Has detailed mural of Michelangelo's "The Last Judgment" painted on ceiling of his apartment.


First through the door in raid and shot three times in 2009. Three weeks in Lenox Hospital.

While intoxicated in 2012 was taken to BELLEVUE HOSPITAL. Initially diagnosed with Schizophrenic Dissociation. Claims to have regular conversations with Pogues lead singer SHANE MACGOWAN who lives in Dublin, Ireland.

SPOUSE: GINA CORIGLIANO CREDENCE. High School sweetheart. Filed for divorce 11/2015). In 2013 initiated IAD investigation by testifying that husband (Daniel Credence) had become addicted to cocaine after two years of undercover work in Washington Heights. Testified he was also having sexual relations with his then partner Thalia Rodriguez, later retracted claim. Presently residing in Oyster Bay with BRIAN NEGLON, managing partner at Oracle Capital Inc.

CHILDREN: DYLAN CREDENCE. Age Nine. Lives with mother. Father is petitioning court for joint custody but is currently three months behind on support payments. Refuses Council. Representing himself in case.









FATHER: JACK CREDENCE (AGE 66) INCARCERATED.

Vietnam Veteran. Awarded Silver Star. Turned down
for parole nine consecutive years. Accused of child
abuse and neglect of children following death of wife.

Nineteen year-old Daniel Credence defended his sister
after physical confrontation. Daniel estified against
his father in domestic assault case, after life
threatening injuries were sustained by his sister as
well as responding officer Tavon Rogers, who was
thrown out of a second story window by Jack Credence.

### KNOWN ASSOCIATES:

BRAD MONAGHAN (cousin) Age 35. NYPD Bronx. Presently under IAD review for corruption.

JIMMY MONAGHAN (cousin) Age 32. NYPD Bronx. Presently under IAD review for corruption and intimidation.

AISHWANYA "Ash" RAMSON. Early thirties. Born in Mumbai, raised in London. Educated at Oxford by way of Eaton. Believed to be a Government Operative but unconfirmed. May work for MI6. In so deep that she may not be able to find her way back.

Ash sees subjects Credence and Andras better than they see themselves. Better than she sees herself. She knows these men better than she knows herself. This is her flaw, conflict, demon. It also makes her the most reckless of the three. She's always all in and doesn't know when to stop.

From wiretap (11/15) to subject Credence:
"You're sweet but you're one of those. You can't
heal me, fix me or make me better. I don't need it."






#### RIVAL:

ANDRAS GOLOVKIN. Early thirties. Muscular, long hair, covered in Russian prison tattoos. Enforcer for The Odessa Mafia (Brighton Beach, New York). Former solider of the Bratva in St. Petersburg. Believed to be the notorious serial killer known as "Ghost". Has been linked to as many as sixty murders in Moscow and Eastern Europe. According to Interpol Dossier, he has resorted back to an almost primitive form: "He's not so much a psychopath as he is the Archetypal Id being of the Psychic Apparatus. Body needs, body wants. Body kills."
